

RRHS Swim Boosters – Instructions for UT Football Game
Saturday, Nov 21 -- Kickoff is 7 p.m.
Stand opens for business at 5 p.m.

Wrist Bands: Each worker must wear the blue wristband that is enclosed.

Enter Stadium: Gate 25 – North End-zone. That is opposite from the end with the huge scoreboard. This is the ONLY gate you can use. There is a stadium map with our booth clearly marked here:

Stand: We are in stand W8. From Gate 25 – go to your right (west). You will go down a big flight of stairs. Keep going in that direction. You will run into the “tunnel” which may be blocked but you can go around. Keep going west and down more stairs until you reach the bottom level. Our stand is located across from the Pizza Hut stand on the bottom floor - northwest endzone area.

Parking: There is no free shuttle this year. You will probably have to pay to park – up to \$10. Please read the following to get current info on parking. Try turning on Dean Keaton -- there is free city parking there. You have to back in at an angle.

Shuttle: Shuttle pickup will be at Barton Creek Mall and the Intramural Fields as it has been in the past. The cost is \$8 round trip.

Attire:

Plain white shirt – no logos no other colors

Solid-colored pants, jeans or shorts

Close toed shoes

No tank tops, no sandals

You will be given a red apron and hat that must be worn

Time: The stand will open for business at 5 p.m. Factor in time for parking and walking a long distance to the stadium.

Window Workers: Arrive at stand no later than 4:15 p.m. (you can arrive earlier).

Set-up workers: Arrive at stand by 3:30 p.m.

Cooks: Arrive at stand by 3 p.m.

Booth and Money Managers: Arrive at stand by 2 p.m.

Food & Breaks:

Concession workers can eat and drink in the stand for free with a few exceptions. You must pay for “packaged” items such as bottled water, candy, peanuts.

You must “sign” for any food you consume so we are not charged for it.

We will try to give workers breaks as needed. There will be time to eat before the booth opens.

Departure:

We begin shutting down the windows in the 3rd quarter of the game under the direction of the UT staff, Workers who arrive first (cooks, set-up) get to leave first. Window workers will be allowed to leave as soon as the booth is clean.

Everyone who is signed up to work is expected to show up on time. You are responsible to find a replacement if you cannot attend. An adult window worker must be replaced by an adult. **Booth Manager this week is Lyle Salam and assistant is Ken Blatz.**
